## BPA Completes Major Pipeline Diversion in Canvey Island

On 6th December 2011 British Pipeline Agency Limited (BPA) successfully completed a £280k diversion of a section of the UKOP pipeline system as part of the Roscommon Way extension in Canvey Island.

BPA provided design, engineering and construction management services to this project. The 120m diversion (including a road crossing) took 8 weeks to design and 8 weeks to construct. Due to the significant ecological importance of the area which is home to a number of protected species, the project required special planning and particular execution.

The pipeline diversion, safely completed on time and on budget, was part of the 18-month highway extension project which is vital to the regeneration and growth for Canvey Island. During the opening ceremony, Essex County Council Chairman, Councillor Rodney Bass thanked BPA for our contribution to this important development.
