BPA currently seek to recruit an Electrical Technician to undertake electrical maintenance and inspection duties to meet the requirements of planned maintenance schedules and respond to breakdowns on storage and pipeline systems operated by BPA at Buncefield and within the South Sector of BPA.

### Duties will include

Work to planned maintenance, inspection procedures and schedules.

Response to corrective maintenance and inspection defects, maintaining records and plant history files.

Keeping of up to date maintenance records utilising the company Computerised Maintenance Management System [CMMS].

Maintenance and management of essential spares stock and identify obsolescence.

Supervision of colleagues and contractors in safe systems of work, including preparation of risk assessments, work procedures, method statements and gas testing procedures.

Response to emergency situations including dealing with emergency authorities.

Working additional hours to fulfil extraordinary maintenance and inspection duties and project work.

### Required Experience / Job Skills

In order to fulfil this role, candidates will have a recognised qualification in a relevant electrical engineering discipline to NVQ level 3 or equivalent Standard, have previous experience in maintenance and fault finding of mechanical plant and equipment and have experience of high voltage, low voltage & extra low voltage electrical systems in an operating and maintaining aspect.

Previous operational experience within the oil, gas or other bulk processing industry is desirable as is a knowledge of relevant safe working practices.
