### Location: Buncefield

We currently seek to recruit an Operations Maintenance Supervisor to be based at the Buncefield site.

The main purpose of the role will be to maintain the systems plant integrity, to supervise the delivery of engineering projects on the operational sites within the BPA's South Sector and to provide support and cover to the Mechanical Maintenance Team Leaders.

### Duties will include:

Completing planned and reactive maintenance tasks to meet statutory and company requirements and maximise plant availability

Preparing and reviewing risk assessments for the control of allocated project and maintenance works

Acting as the Site Operating Authority under the permit to work system and providing supervision for construction works

Fulfilling the role of Operations focal point for engineering projects by providing input into design, planning and construction

Resolving unplanned events to ensure site operation remains in a safe condition

Preparing the site for project works by ensuring all the relative mechanical and electrical isolations by appropriate authorities

Ensuring on site safe working practices

Line supervision of technicians for all staff related matters

### Required Experience / Job Skills:

To fulfil this role we are looking for candidates that have a qualification in a relevant mechanical or multi skilled discipline attained through a certified apprenticeship or equivalent vocational development route.

Candidates must also have previous working experience within a process plant operations environment and possess technical knowledge with an ability to logically and analytically fault find to solve problems.

Candidates will also need to be computer literate, knowledgeable in site safety working practices and have an awareness of statutory legislation on HSEQ matters.

A full/clean valid UK driving licence is an essential pre requisite of these roles and a company vehicle will be provided. NB: Participation in an out of hours call out rota will be required.
