Location: North Walsham

We currently seek to recruit an Operations Technician to undertake railcar loading, oil tank farm operations, maintenance duties and pipeline patrols on the BPA Bacton / North Walsham condensate disposal system and Bacton to Great Yarmouth fuel gas pipelines.

Duties will include:

Monitoring, inspection and maintenance of major accident hazard pipelines.

Operational duties associated with pipeline pumping, tank farm movements and railhead loading.

Supervising rail operation train delivery, inspection and despatch procedures.

Maintaining operational site and pipeline inspection and maintenance schedules and records.

Performing duties in accordance with the condensate disposal system and schedules.

Supervising colleagues and contractors in safe systems of work including risk assessment and gas testing procedures.

Responding to emergency situations and liaising with emergency authorities and statutory bodies.

Required Experience / Job Skills:

In order to fulfil this role we are looking for candidates that have previous operational experience within the oil, gas or other bulk processing industry and candidates that have previous experience in a mechanical maintenance role. Candidates will also need to be able to demonstrate that they have knowledge and a working understanding of the risk assessment process and safe systems of work.

Candidates must have excellent communication skills, be an enthusiastic team player and have basic PC skills with the ability to update spreadsheets and use a computerised maintenance system.

Please also note that the ability to work on a rotating shift pattern and working additional hours is an essential requirement of this role as is a valid UK driving licence.
