We currently seek to recruit a Mechanical Maintenance Team Leader to provide site and mechanical supervisory responsibilities at Kingsbury and within the North Sector of BPA.

The main purpose of this role will be to maintain the systems plant integrity, to supervise operational, maintenance and project activities and mechanical matters and provide overall supervision requirements for monitoring the completion of all discipline scheduled maintenance activities.

Duties will include:

Managing and organising the workload for the Kingsbury mechanical maintenance team.

Responsibility for the delivery of planned and corrective maintenance and inspection tasks at allocated sites.

Acting as Operating Authority and Level 2 permit authority supervising colleagues and contractors.

Quality system document holder and site representative of external and internal audits of safety, quality and environmental management systems.

Line supervision of direct reports for all staff related matters

Required Experience / Job Skills:

To fulfil this role we are looking for candidates that have a qualification in a relevant mechanical or multi skilled discipline attained through a certified apprenticeship or equivalent vocational development route.

Candidates must also have previous working experience within a general process plant industry, have an ability to logically fault find to solve problems and have previous experience in the management of personnel and dealing with 3rd party contractors. Candidates will also need to be computer literate, knowledgeable in site safety working practices and have an awareness of statutory legislation on HSEQ matters.
