We currently seek to recruit an Operations Technician to undertake safe and efficient operations and operational maintenance tasks on the Bacton/North Walsham Condensate Disposal System and other allocated operational facilities.

### Duties will include:

Operational duties associated with pipeline pumping, tank farm movements and railhead loading.

Supervising Rail Operator train delivery, inspection and despatch procedures.

Fulfilling a role on the 24/7 standby rota to deal with alarms, emergencies and other operational issues.

Completing allocated maintenance and inspection tasks as required and update records in accordance with company systems.

Monitoring, inspection and maintenance of major accident hazard pipelines.

Supervising colleagues and contractors in safe systems of work including risk assessment and gas testing procedures.

Responding to emergency situations and liaising with emergency authorities and statutory bodies.

### Required Experience / Job Skills:

In order to fulfil this role we are looking for candidates that have previous operational experience within the oil, gas or other bulk processing industry and experience with plant maintenance would be an advantage.

Candidates will also need to be able to demonstrate that they have knowledge and a working understanding of the risk assessment process and safe systems of work.
