We currently seek to recruit two Mechanical Technicians to undertake mechanical maintenance and inspection duties to meet the requirements of planned maintenance schedules and respond to breakdowns on storage and pipeline systems operated by BPA at Buncefield with remit to cover across whole of BPA within UK and in the Southern Sector of BPA.

Duties will include:

Working to planned maintenance, inspection procedures and schedules.

Responding to corrective maintenance and inspection defects, maintaining records and plant history files.

Supervising colleagues and contractors in safe systems of work, including preparing risk assessments, work procedures, method statements and gas testing procedures.

Responding to emergency situations including dealing with emergency authorities.

Working additional hours to fulfil extraordinary maintenance and inspection duties and project work.

Required Experience / Job Skills:

In order to fulfil this role, candidates will have a recognised qualification in a relevant mechanical or engineering discipline to NVQ level 3 or equivalent standard and have previous experience in maintenance and fault finding of mechanical plant and equipment.

Previous operational experience within the oil, gas or other bulk processing industry is preferable although not essential.

Candidates must have knowledge of relevant safe working practices associated with COSHH, Confined Space Entry, Lifting Operations, Pressure Vessels and Pipework Systems, Hydraulic Systems and Workshop tasks.

Candidates must have the ability to work under their own initiative and be able to prioritise their own workload.
